IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Return of Party Enrollments in Primary Elections.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 4., § 29-A, additional. Chapter 4 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 29-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 29-A. Return of party enrollment. Within 10 days after the primary election each city, town and plantation clerk shall make a return on a blank provided by the secretary of state of the total number of voters enrolled in each political party in such municipality at the close of the polls on primary election day.'
