RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Jay.

Town of Jay reimbursed. Resolved: That the sum of \$166 be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid to the town of Jay, to reimburse said town for the burial expenses of Mrs. Elizabeth Goodspeed, a non-resident of said town; said sum to be paid from the general fund of the state.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The town of Jay paid for the burial expenses of Mrs. Goodspeed who had been living in the town of Jay for about 1 month.

Mrs. Goodspeed was the divorced wife of Lester F. Goodspeed formerly of Fayette, Vienna, and Rumford, but as they did not live in any of these towns long enough to gain residence the town was unable to collect from any of these towns.
