

## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 96th LEGISLATURE

HOUSE AMENDMENT "D" to S. P. 538, L. D. 1451, Bill "An Act Amending the Water Improvement Commission and Creating Standards of Classification."

Amend said Bill by inserting in the 6th line of the paragraph beginning "Class C waters" in the section numberes "Sec. 2" after the underlined words "stream flow" the underlined words and punctuation ; for the particular season involved:

Further amend said Bill by striking out the second sentence in the paragraph beginning "Class D waters" in the section numbered "Sec. 2" and substituting the following underlined sentence:

<sup>1</sup>During a period of temporary reduction in the dissolved oxygen content in this class water, due to abnormal conditions of temperature or stream flow for the particular season involved, the commission, provided a nuisance condition has not then been created in such water and in the opinion of the commission is not likely to be created during such season, shall take no action to reduce the amount of pollution from any source which is allowed in such class water under normal conditions.<sup>1</sup>

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end of the 3rd paragraph of that part designated Sec. 1-A of Sec. 2 thereof, the following underlined sentence:

Such waters may be used for log-driving or other commercial purposes which will not lower its classification.

Further amend said Bill by inserting in Section 4 after the words "The following rivers are exempted" the underlined words 'until the 1st day of September 1955 and no longer', and by striking out in the 9th line of said section the words and punctuation ", mill wastes, shavings or fibrous materials" and inserting in place thereof the underlined words 'or shavings'.
