**AN ACT to Permit Testing of Anti-Aircraft Weapons and Munitions Over
a Part of Moosehead Lake.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 1, § 23-A, additional. Chapter 1 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 23-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 23-A. Use of area over Moosehead lake for testing anti-aircraft weapons and munitions. For a period for two years only, except during the months of May and June, the state military defense commission shall have the authority to license persons to use that part of Moosehead lake comprising the area between a line drawn from Williams Stream cove to Norcross Point, and a line drawn from Beaver brook to Little Duck cove, for the purpose of testing and proving anti-aircraft weapons and munitions in the air over said area. The commission may condition the granting of such license upon such terms and subject to such restrictions as it may prescribe, having in mind the safety of the public and indemnity for any possible injury to person or damage to property.'
