AN ACT Relating to Salary of Director of Legislative Research.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 9, § 25, sub-§ VII, amended. The last sentence of subsection VII of section 25 of chapter 9 of the revised statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 1 of chapter 392 of the public laws of 1947 and amended by section 1 of chapter 412 of the public laws of 1951, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'He (director of legislative research) shall receive a salary of ~~\$7,000~~ \$8,000 per year and any necessary traveling expenses.'

Sec. 2. Effective date. The provisions of this act shall become effective for the week ending July 11, 1953.
