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**AN ACT Relating to Salary of Attorney-General.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Sec. 1. R. S., c. 17, § 1, amended.** The 6th sentence of the 1st paragraph of section 1 of chapter 17 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'The attorney-general shall have an office in the state capitol and shall receive an annual salary of ~~\$7,000~~ \$8,000 in full for all services and in lieu of all fees.'

**Sec. 2. Effective date.** The provisions of this act shall become effective for the week ending July 11, 1953.
