STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Northern Maine Sanatorium.

Northern Maine Sanatorium construction and improvements; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund the sum of \$12,000 to permit the completion of the employees' dormitory at Northern Maine Sanatorium. Such expenditures shall be as recommended by the commissioner of institutional service and approved by the governor and council.

Any balances at June 30, 1954 shall be carried forward to the 1954-1955 fiscal year, but all unencumbered balances shall lapse June 30, 1955.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The Northern Maine Sanatorium is a TB Sanatorium with an estimated patient population of 100. The 94th legislature provided \$20,000 for an employees' dormitory for married couples. Of this sum, \$19,940.93 remains available, since the \$20,000 was found to be inadequate. The provisions of this Act will so augment the presently available balance as to permit the completion of this dormitory unit.
