SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 593, L. D. 1538, Bill "An Act  
Relating to Hearings Before the Insurance  
Commissioner."

Amend said Bill in that part designated "Sec. 309" by  
striking out the 6th underlined sentence thereof, which reads  
as follows:

"The commissioner or person conducting the hearing may adjourn  
any hearing from time to time or place to place without any  
notice of the adjournment other than an announcement thereof  
at the hearing."
