STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FIFTY-FOUR

RESOLVE in Favor of Maine Maritime Academy.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, appropriations for the Maine Maritime Academy have not been sufficient to carry on the functions of the Academy; and

Whereas, the education of our youth is essential and to continue this education additional funds are necessary; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it

Maine Maritime Academy; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund of the state the sum of \$18,000 to carry on the functions of the Maine Maritime Academy until June 30, 1955.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve shall take effect when approved.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The appropriations made for the Maine Maritime Academy for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1955 were not adequate to carry out the functions of the Academy and additional funds are necessary for this purpose.
