STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FOUR

RESOLVE, Providing for Additional Funds for the State Liquor Warehouse.

State Liquor Commission; appropriation. Resolved: There is hereby appropriated from the working capital of the Maine State Liquor Commission the sum of \$90,000 for the completion of the liquor warehouse in Hallowell. Such appropriations shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this resolve have been accomplished.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

At the last session of the Legislature, the sum of \$325,000 was appropriated for the purpose of constructing a wholesale liquor warehouse in Hallowell. With the authority granted by this resolve, the liquor commission can complete the Hallowell structure so as to provide for both the Hallowell retail outlet and the state liquor warehouse; will also provide adequate office space for the commission and for making more efficient operation, releasing the state office building of the liquor requirements and permit the motor vehicle department to be housed in the state office building.
