STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Repealing the Size of Smoked Herring Boxes in Fish Packing.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 23, repealed. Section 23 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed, as follows:

'See. 23. Size of smoked herring boxes. No person, firm or corporation engaged in the state in buying, selling or packing of smoked herring shall sell or offer for sale smoked herring in boxes of less than the following dimensions; \Rightarrow inches in depth, 6 inches in width, inside measure, and $\pm \Rightarrow$ inches in length, outside measure. Wheever packs, sells or offers for sale smoked herring in boxes in violation of this section shall forfeit 25e for each box so packed, sold or offered for sale; but this section does not apply to boxes of boncless herring.'

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
