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**AN ACT Repealing the Size of Smoked Herring Boxes in Fish Packing.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 38, § 23, repealed.** Section 23 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed, as follows:

'Sec. 23. Size of smoked herring boxes. No person, firm or corporation engaged in the state in buying, selling or packing of smoked herring shall sell or offer for sale smoked herring in boxes of less than the following dimensions; 2 inches in depth, 6 inches in width, inside measure, and 12 inches in length, outside measure. Whoever packs, sells or offers for sale smoked herring in boxes in violation of this section shall forfeit 25¢ for each box so packed, sold or offered for sale; but this section does not apply to boxes of boneless herring.'
