STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Open Season on Deer in Vinalhaven.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 91, amended. The 8th paragraph of section 91 of chapter 37 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'There shall be a continual closed season on deer in the town of Vinalhaven, Knox county, and the islands within the confines of the town of Vinalhaven, until July 1, 1957. After July 1, 1957 during the open season on deer it shall be unlawful to hunt deer with rifles or shotgun slugs in the town of Vinalhaven, Knox county, and the islands within the confines of the town of Vinalhaven.'
