## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Exempting Certain Materials Used by Commercial Fishermen from the Sales Tax.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 17, § 10, sub-§ VII-A, additional. Section 10 of chapter 17 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new subsection to be numbered VII-A, to read as follows:

'VII-A. Lobster traps, seine twine, etc. Sales of buoys, pot warp, heading twine, drag nets and materials used in the construction of lobster traps sold to commercial fishermen.'
