SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 38, L.D. 27, Bill, "An Act Relating to Descent of Real Estate in Divorce Cases."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end thereof the following underlined paragraph:

"'No such rights acquired under the provisions of said sections
63 and 65, after September 1, 1955, shall be effectual against the
libelee or any other person, unless said abstract of the decree of
divorce shall have been recorded, in the manner hereinabove provided, within 1 year from the date of said decree of divorce.'"
