HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 22, L.D. 37, "Resolve, to Apportion One Hundred and Fifty-one Representatives Among the Several Counties, Cities, Towns, Plantations and Classes in the State of Maine.

Amend said Resolve by striking out in the 5th line of the last paragraph thereof, the name "North Kennebunk" and inserting in place thereof the name 'North Kennebunkport'

Further amend said Resolve by striking out in the last paragraph thereof, the last six words and punctuation "Acton, Alfred, and Dayton, one representative." and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Hollis, Buxton, Lyman and Dayton, one representative; Alfred, Acton, Newfield, Waterboro and Shapleigh, one representative.'
