AN ACT Relating to Appropriations by Municipalities for Advertising.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., c. 91, § 108, amended. Section 108 of chapter 91 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows :

'**Sec. 108. Advertising.** Any city or town may appropriate any sum, not exceeding ~~1 mill~~ **2 mills** on a dollar, based on the valuation of the preceding year, to be expended and used for advertising the natural resources, advantages and attractions of the State or such city or town.'
