## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 97th LEGISLATURE

SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 79, L.D. 76, Bill, "An Act Relating to the Closing of County Offices on Saturday."

Amend said Bill by inserting before the Enacting Clause the following Emergency Preamble:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless passed as emergencies; and

Whereas, in order to permit the closing of the county offices of clerk of courts during the summer months of 1955, it is necessary that the following legislation become effective as soon as possible; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end thereof the following Emergency Clause:

\*Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this act shall take effect when approved.
