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**STATE OF MAINE**

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**RESOLVE, in Favor of the Maine Historical Society.**

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**Maine Historical Society; appropriation for. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund of the state in favor of the Maine Historical Society, the sum of \$2,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1956; and the sum of \$2,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1957; the same to be paid in quarterly payments commencing on October 1, 1955.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The Maine Historical Society, a state-wide nonprofit organization, maintains an historical library in Portland, Maine, which is continually consulted by students of Maine History and research writers not only throughout the State, but from all parts of the Country. Its income is derived from the customary State appropriation, an income from invested funds, dues from members, and the receipts from summer visitors to The Longfellow House, which is owned and must be kept in repair by the Society.
