AN ACT Relating to Removal of the Old Vaughan Bridge.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1949, c. 154, § 3, amended. Section 3 of chapter 154 of the private and special laws of 1949 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 3. Vaughan bridge to be removed. As soon as practicable after said bridge shall be completed and ready for use, the commission shall cause the existing highway drawbridge across Fore river known as Vaughan bridge to be wholly removed, **except for such portion of said bridge as may be authorized to remain in place by the U. S. Corps of Engineers. In case any such portion is authorized to remain in place, the State Highway Commission is authorized to dispose of any interest the State may have in the property to the highest bidder, with the approval of the Governor and Council.'**

Sec. 2. Vaughan Bridge discontinued as a way. All of that part of the highway that existed between the northerly and southerly sides of Fore river, and was travelled via Vaughan bridge, so called, is hereby discontinued as a public way.
