**RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing for Smallmouth Black Bass, Pickerel and
White Perch on Mount Desert Island.**

Fishing on Mount Desert Island; regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation that there shall be no size or bag limits on smallmouth black bass, pickerel and white perch in Long Pond, Hancock county, and its tributaries or in any connected lakes or ponds and their tributaries including Round Pond, Ripple Pond, and Somes Pond; and that there shall be no size or bag limits on smallmouth black bass, pickerel and white perch in Echo Lake, Hancock county, and its tributaries or in any connected lakes or ponds and their tributaries, including Little Echo Lake; and that the fishing season for smallmouth black bass, pickerel and white perch in all the aforementioned waters be made concurrent with that in existence for salmon and trout, and that any lures or gear legal for the taking of salmon and trout be legal for the taking of smallmouth black bass, pickerel and white perch.
