IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in West Branch of Penobscot River.

Fishing in West Branch of Penobscot River, regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game, be and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation to open the West Branch of the Penobscot River from Ripogenus Dam to Debsconeag Falls to fly fishing and trolling with artificial flies only.
