COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 151, L. D. 151, Bill, "An Act to
Clarify Certain Election Laws."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of Section 5 thereof and
inserting in place thereof, the following:

'Sec. 5. R. S., c. 4, Sec. 54, amended. Section 54 of
chapter 4 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by inserting
before the last sentence thereof, the following underlined
sentence:

Whenever state, county, city or town committees are required
by law to nominate candidates for public office, a certificate
as provided in section 57 shall be filed with the Secretary of
State at least 5 days following such nomination.'
