COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 167, L. D. 158, Bill, "An Act  
Relating to the Taking of Clams, Etc., in  
Town of Harpswell."

Amend said Bill by striking out the Title and inserting in  
place thereof a New Title to read as follows:

'An Act Relating to the Taking of Clams or Quahogs in the  
Town of Harpswell.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out in the 4th line of  
that part designated "Sec. 70-A" the underlined words "clams,  
quahogs, clamworms, sandworms or bloodworms" and inserting in  
place thereof the underlined words 'clams or quahogs'

Further amend said Bill by striking out in the 2nd line and  
the last line of that part designated "Sec. 70-B" the underlined  
words "clams, quahogs, clamworms or bloodworms" and inserting in  
place thereof the underlined words 'clams or quahogs'

Further amend said Bill by striking out in the 4th, 5th, 6th  
and 7th lines of that part designated "Sec. 70-C" the underlined  
words "clams, quahogs, clamworms, bloodworms or sandworms" and  
inserting in place thereof the underlined words 'clams or quahogs'
