STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Increase the Salary of the Recorder of the Calais Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1883, c. 325, § 24, amended. The last sentence of section 24 of chapter 325 of the private and special laws of 1883, as amended by section 2 of chapter 50 of the private and special laws of 1919, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Said recorder shall be appointed for a term of 4 years, and as compensation in full for his services shall receive three hundred dollars \$600 per year, payable by the county of Washington in the same manner as the salary of said judge.'
