AN ACT Relating to Fees for Motor Vehicle Inspection Stations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 47, amended. Section 47 of chapter 22 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 47. Fee for licenses. The operator of any official inspection station shall conduct the inspection of motor vehicles presented to him for that purpose in accordance with rules and regulations promulgated by the secretary of state, for which he shall receive a fee of ~~50c~~ **75c** for each car inspected, this sum not to include labor or material used in correction of faults in equipment.'
