STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Clerk Hire in the Office of the Recorder of the Portland Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 89, § 254, amended. The 4th paragraph of section 254 of chapter 89 of the revised statutes is hereby amended so that said paragraph, so far as it relates to the amount to be paid for clerk hire in the office of the recorder of the Portland Municipal Court, shall read as follows:

'for clerks in the office of the recorder of the Portland municipal court, \$5,096 \$5,980;'
