STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Fee for Permits Granted by Board of Harbor Commissioners for Harbor of Portland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- P. & S. L., 1917, c. 192, § 7, amended. Section 7 of chapter 192 of the private and special laws of 1917 is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 7. Members of board to receive no compensation; fee for permit, how expended. No compensation shall be paid to the members of said board for their services; but if a permit be granted, twenty five dollars \$75 shall be paid by the petitioner to said board, the same to be applied by said board in paying expenses of the board in connection with applications for permits and in carrying out the purposes of this act.'
