# STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

### AN ACT Relating to Fees of Deputy Sheriffs in Attendance at Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 89, § 150, sub § XV, amended.** Subsection XV of section 150 of chapter 89 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'XV. Every deputy sheriff and court messenger, while in attendance upon the supreme judicial court or the superior court in their several counties, shall receive for said attendance and service \$10 a day while the court is in session to run continuously from the convening of the court until adjournment, plus their necessary travel at 20c a mile form their place of abode for each day's attendance.'
