RESOLVE, in Favor of Gerard Pomerleau of Portland.

Gerard Pomerleau; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$398.54 from the general fund to be paid to Gerard Pomerleau, of Portland, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to his car and contents by four state wards.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

On August 21, 1953, four State School boys escaped and stole Mr. Pomerleau's Pontiac station wagon. Mr. Pomerleau estimates the damage to his car and loss of tools which were in his car to be \$389.54.
