RESOLVE, in Favor of Herschel P. Bugbee of Washburn.

Herschel P. Bugbee; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid to Herschel P. Bugbee, of Washbun, the sum of \$9,000 from the general highway fund as a full and final settlement of his claim against the state for damage to his house and other buildings when moved in 1953 to relocate part of the Federal Aid Highway in the town of Washburn.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Contract between Mr. Bugbee and the State in 1953 to move Mr. Bugbee's home and other buildings because of relocation of Federal Aid Highway in Washburn. In moving said buildings, a great deal of damage was done, such as plaster completely ruined, floors out of level, etc.
