RESOLVE, Reappropriating Road Resolve Funds in Town of Boothbay Harbor.

Town of Boothbay Harbor; money reallocated. Resolved: That the sum of \$950 accumulated from special road resolves appropriated by previous legislatures to aid in repairing the road leading from West Boothbay Harbor over road west of West Harbor Pond to Boothbay Center, be, and hereby is, reappropriated to be expended for reconstruction of State Aid #2, being a part of State route #27, between Boothbay Harbor village and the Southport town line.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Money has not been previously expended and State Aid #2 is badly in need of repair.
