STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Boundaries of Stockholm Game Preserve.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 149, amended. That part of section 149 of chapter 37 of the revised statutes which relates to Stockholm Game Preserve is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Stockholm Game Preserve: The following described territory, situated in the town of Stockholm and T. 16, R. 4, in the county of Aroostook beginning at a point on state road No. 161 at a point where Bangor & Aroostook R. R. erosses the Little Madawaska River meets said highway and extending in an easterly and northerly direction along the Little Madawaska River to a point where the river and the Bangor & Aroostook R. R. meet and extending in an easterly and northerly direction along the right-of-way of said railroad approximately 6 miles to the southern boundary of T. 17, R. 3, thence west along southern boundary of T. 17, R. 3, also T. 17, R. 4, to highway 161 thence in a soltheasterly direction along highway 161 to point of beginning; the above described area containing approximately 12,000 acres.'
