STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Exemption Under Electricians' Licensing Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 82, § 13, sub-§ IX, additional. Section 13 of chapter 82 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new subsection to be numbered IX, to read as follows:
 - 'IX. The electrical work included in the installation, alteration, maintenance and repair of electrically operated or controlled heating, air conditioning and refrigeration equipment including all accessory equipment, control systems, and all wiring in connection therewith to a suitable distribution panel or disconnect switch, but excluding all other electrical equipment and work in the building or structure where the above equipment is installed, provided, however, that continued failure to conform with applicable regulations of the National Electrical Code, National Electrical Safety Code or of other safety codes which have been approved by the American Standards Association shall render any person, firm or corporation, responsible therefor liable to the penalties imposed by section 14 hereof.'
