STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Paying of Deficiency of Truck Registration Fees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 15, § 13, amended. Section 13 of chapter 15 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 13. Enforcement of §§ 8-13; records. Every state police officer sheriff and deputy sheriff is authorized and directed to enforce the provisions of sections 8 to 13, inclusive, and to keep a complete record of each truck weighed by him, and he shall send a copy of each such record, prior to the close of the month following that during which the weighing took place, to the Chief of the State Police who shall file the same as a public record. Forms for making such records shall be prepared by the Chief of the State Police and by him furnished together with a copy of sections 8 to 13, inclusive, to all state police officers sheriffs and deputy sheriffs.'
