STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Fees for Registration of Motor Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., c. 22, § 16, sub-§ I, ¶ A, repealed and replaced. Paragraph A of subsection I of section 16 of chapter 22 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:
 - 'A. Used for the conveyance of passengers, \$15. Vehicles of the station-wagon type which are used interchangeably for the conveyance of passengers or property shall pay the above fee. Such vehicles shall be designated as "convertibles."
- Sec. 2. R. S., c. 22, § 16, sub-§ I, ¶ E, repealed. Paragraph E of subsection I of section 16 of chapter 22 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed, as follows:
 - 'E. Used interchangeably for conveyance of passengers or property shall pay either the fee provided by paragraph A of this subsection or by section 19, whichever is the greater. Such vehicles shall be designed as "convertibles."
