STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Instruction in Use of Firearms in Public Schools and Appropriation Therefor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 41, § 39-A, additional. Chapter 41 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 39-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 39-A. Use of firearms. Towns, cities and school districts may include in their public schools the instruction in the safe and proper use of firearms, including instruction in game laws and good hunting practices and raise and appropriate money for said purposes.'
