IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Henry Michaud, of South Berwick.

Henry Michaud; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appriated, the sum of \$610.75, to be paid to Henry Michaud, of South Berwick, as a full and final settlement against the State, to compensate him for hospital and doctors' bills incurred by him in treatment for injuries caused by one Leo Rouselle, a state charge; said sum to be paid from the general funds of the State.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Leo Rouselle, a state charge, lived with the Michauds at the time of the injury. Henry Michaud has had to have operations on his nose, hospitalization, x-rays, treatments from doctors.
