STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, Authorizing State Highway Commission to Study Desirability of Bridge and Causeways connecting Littlejohn's Island and Chebeague Island in Casco Bay with the Mainland.

Bridge and Causeway across Casco Bay to Chebeague Island; study authorized. Resolved: That the State Highway Commission be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to make a study of the need and cost of a highway bridge and causeways between Cousin's and Littlejohn's Islands in the town of Yarmouth, and between Littlejohn's Island in the town of Yarmouth, and Chebeague Island in the town of Cumberland, and county of Cumberland, across the waters of Casco Bay, with necessary highway approaches thereto; and be it further

Resolved: That the Commission shall report the results of their study at the next regular session of the legislature.
