STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing for Black Bass in Washington County.

Fishing for black bass in Washington county; regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game, be and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation making the black bass open season in Washington county to conform with the general law on black bass, with the exception that fishing for black bass from June I through June 20 be restricted to use of single hooked artificial lures.
