**RESOLVE, Closing Little Jim Pond, in Franklin and Somerset Counties
to Fishing Except Fly Fishing.**

Little Jim Pond closed to all fishing except fly fishing. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation closing Little Jim Pond in Franklin and Somerset counties to all fishing except fly fishing and establishing a day limit of 5 fish or 7½ pounds per person per day.
