IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Goose Pond, York County.

Fishing in Goose Pond; regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation to remove all size and bag limits on white perch, pickerel and bass in Goose Pond in the town of Shapleigh, York County. The open season to conform with the general law ice fishing and open water fishing seasons in all waters.
