**RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Little Ossippee Pond.**

---

**Fishing in Little Ossippee Pond; regulated. Resolved:** That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation removing all limits as to the size and number of perch, pickerel, bass and other warm water species of fish that may be taken from Little Ossippee Pond in the town of Waterboro, and county of York.
