AN ACT Defining Vessel under Public Utility Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 44, § 16, sub-§ XXIV, amended. Subsection XXIV of section 16 of chapter 44 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

XXIV. "Vessel" includes every steamboat **or boat powered by diesel engines** which is owned, controlled, operated or managed for public use in the transportation of persons or property for compensation within this State.'
