STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, Providing for State Pension for Gertrude B. Thompson of Chelsea.

Gertrude Thompson; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$40 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Gertrude Thompson, of Chelsea, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1955 and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Gertrude Beatrice Thompson is 61 years of age; husband is 69 and receives old age assistance. Adopted son now at Pownal, and they have no other living children. Mrs. Thompson has to see doctor twice a month. Mr. Thompson also has poor health. Neither is able to work. Need assistance.
