**RESOLVE, Providing for State Pension Increase for Charles Bowen of
Newburg.**

Charles Bowen; state pension increase. Resolved: That a pension of \$55 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Charles Bowen, of Newburg, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin July 1, 1955, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

That part of chapter 94 of the resolves of 1953 which provides for a state pension for Charles Bowen, of Newburg, is hereby repealed.

Has polio, has use of only left arm. Has been in wheelchair for 25 years. Needs increase to provide necessities of life.
