STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, Providing for State Pension for Marian Martin of Rumford.

Marian Martin; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$50 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Marian Martin, of Rumford, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1955 and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Marian Martin is 30 years old. Father is retired and mother has asthma and is under doctor's care. She was in a sanatorium from 1942 to 1944 and then from 1946 to 1951. Has had operation on both lungs.. Will not be able to work for long time then only light work. Goes to Boston for checkup every 3 months.
