STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, Providing for State Pension for Victor James of Princeton.

Victor James; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$50 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Victor James, of Princeton, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1955 and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Victor James is 43 years of age. He has been crippled all his life and cannot work. Needs assistance to maintain a decent living.
