**RESOLVE, Providing for State Pension for Charles H. Nutter of
Newport.**

Charles H. Nutter; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$50 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Charles H. Nutter of Newport, to be paid monthly from the appropriation for special legislative pensions. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1955 and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Charles H. Nutter is 62 years of age. His left arm has been removed above the elbow. Left leg has been broken and never mended properly. Cannot walk easily. Needs assistance to provide the necessities of life.
