RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Kittery.

Town of Kittery; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated in favor of the town of Kittery the sum of \$25,000 from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund for the purpose of rebuilding the town wharf at Kittery Point.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Hurricane Carol destroyed the present town wharf at Kittery Point. This dock is advantageous not only to the town of Kittery but to the State of Maine being the only publicly controlled wharfage in a harbor of any consequence south of Portland harbor. The lobster fishing industry in this section is greatly dependent on this wharf as well as yachts visiting Maine in season.
